The programs listed below are sponsored by the Middletown Commission on the Arts and run by NEAR (North End Arts Rising), Inc. and Oddfellows Playhouse. *Programs do not meet July 5, 2010.*

FEE STRUCTURE (Full Payment Must Accompany Registration)

- *Households receiving Temporary Aid to Families (TAF), or qualify for free school lunches under State of CT guidelines:** no cost
- *Households receiving reduced price school lunches or food stamps:** \$25/household
- *Reduced Rate for families whose weekly income exceeds, by up to \$192.30, the standards for reduced price school meals (see chart):** \$50 first child; \$25 ea. add'l child
- Standard Rate:** \$125 first child; \$75 second child; \$50 ea. add'l. child
- Non-Resident Rate:** \$250 per child (Registrations not accepted prior to 4/1)

***Verification required with submission of application.** Verify with one of the following documents: copy of your "Free or Reduced Price Meal form" from child's school or a Cash Budget Sheet from CT Dept. of Social Services if you are receiving TAF. For those applying for the Reduced Rate (#3 above) the required verification is a copy of your latest IRS 1040EZ, 1040A or 1040 form.

Using foundational design principles we focus on the creativity of artistic expression and the scientific principles of the real world. Connecting art, science and fun - tomorrow's dreams can be realized if we inspire our kids to creatively rise beyond the unknown. Projects include recycled rocketry, object deconstruction/reconstruction, fossil casting and a mural. Peer-cooperation, creativity and attention to detail are encouraged.



TROUBADOUR & MORE

The troubadour legacy is one that has transferred factual and emotional knowledge through generations using the power of song. In this class, students will actively investigate their personal life events and those of their contemporaries in order to communicate and define an experience they consider valuable. Portions of this class will focus on creating a newspaper from the ground up, and the other will focus on music. We aim to empower children as they learn through experience. We will guide them to investigate and report, interview, draw, write songs, sing and create instruments. This class gives foundational strength to aspiring writers, lyricists, musicians and creative minds.

Oddfellows Playhouse Youth Theater presents the 22nd Children's Circus of Middletown. This 5-week, half-day program, which has become a national model, culminates in a spectacular outdoor circus performance before a crowd of over 1,000.

- Week one: training in acrobatics, dance, juggling, unicycling, stilt walking, clowning and visual arts.
- Weeks two & three: choose two areas of specialization from the above disciplines, train daily in these areas and perform at the end of each week.
- Weeks four & five: each participant will be cast into a featured role in a circus act. Create and rehearse acts in preparation for dress rehearsals and performance.

Limited space is available in the Full-Day Advanced Circus Program for returning circus performers ages 12-15. For more information on this aspect of the program call the Playhouse at 860.347.6143

LIMIT: 90 PARTICIPANTS PER SESSION

NOTE: The Kids Arts programs are open to everyone. They do **require a full five (5) week commitment of time and energy.** Skills are gained and refined from Day One. Relationships are based on consistent attendance. Rehearsals, specialization sharing and preparations for the final extravaganza depend on your child being there consistently or they just won't work. **Maximum absences: 3 days. Please do not sign up if your child will be missing more than 3 days.**

Registration for all programs is on a 1st come, 1st served basis. There is limited availability for full-day programming (full-day Circus not allowed). As a requirement for the full-day option, parents/guardians should provide lunches for their child(ren).
