Recycling Regulations

Residents may bring recyclables to the Recycling Center at no charge. Residents must obtain a **residence pass** upon presentation of their **vehicle registration** at the Department of Public Works in City Hall.

Recyclables accepted free of charge:

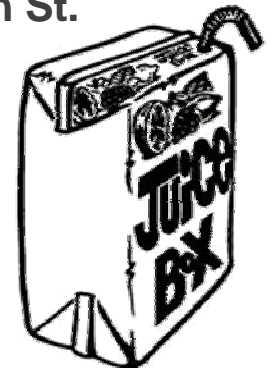
Aluminum foil	Drink boxes	Milk cartons
Antifreeze	Glass containers	Mixed paper
Brush (under 6" diameter)	Junk mail	Newspaper
Catalogs	Lead acid batteries	Paperboard
Corrugated Cardboard	Leaves	#1 - #7 Plastic containers
	Magazines	Waste oil



The Middletown Recycling Center is located on the corner of Johnson Street and North Main Street at 185 Johnson St.

Bulky Waste Charges

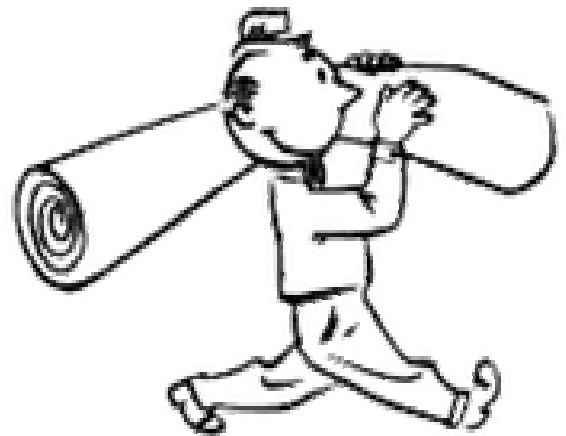
All bulky waste material which enters the Recycling Center will be weighed on a scale and charged according to tonnage.

All bulky waste material will be charged **\$84.50/ton** unless otherwise noted. All vehicles, including cars and SUVs will be charged.

There is a minimum charge of **\$10** for bulky waste.

Bulky Waste Material Includes:

- § Carpentry
- § Demolition & construction debris
- § Furniture
- § Landscaping debris (over 6' in diameter)
- § Scrap metal
- § Wood
- § Other household items:
 - Freon containing items (\$15.00 per unit)
 - Passenger tires (\$3.00 each)
 - Truck tires & tires on rims (\$10 each)
 - **Max of four tires per load.**



Household Electronics

Computer monitor -----	\$10.00 each
Computer system -----	\$15.00 each
Printer -----	\$5.00 each
Scanner -----	\$5.00 each
Telephone -----	\$5.00 each
Television (27" or less) -----	\$10.00 each
Television (over 27") -----	\$20.00 each
VCR, DVD, Radio -----	\$5.00 each

Charges for household electronics will be eliminated when the State Law for electronics is implemented. Anticipated commencement date for this program is March 2010.

Payments may be made on site with Visa/Mastercard or check. A gift card may be purchased at the City Hall if cash payments are preferred.
