RULES:

- § **Eligibility:** Any student, family or youth group in grades K -12th is invited to participate. Entries may be grouped together, depending upon number of entries. Only one student, family or group per entry.
- § **Prizes:** A first and second place prize will be awarded for each category, including a People's Choice Award.
- § **Theme:** Entries must relate to **Let's Go Green** and demonstrate ways to preserve our environment. A brief explanation is always welcome. Entries will be judged based on creative use of materials and artistic excellence.
- § **Size:** The sculpture should not be so large, heavy or delicate that it cannot be easily moved or transported. One person should be able to easily carry the entered sculpture.
- § **Materials:** All entries must be constructed of materials that have been used at least once and would have been recycled or thrown away. No items which contain or previously contained a hazardous substance may be used.
- § **Deadline:** Deadline for receipt of entries by the City is Monday, November 16, 2009, 4:00 pm. All schools and individuals must bring their entries to the Public Works Department by this time. No late entries will be accepted. An official entry form, signed by a parent or guardian, must be attached to each entry to be officially entered into the contest. Winners will be announced the week of November 24th.
- § **Judging:** The decision of the judges is final. Prizes will include items made from recycled materials. Contestants must provide a contact name and phone number if they wish to have their sculpture returned. The City will not store sculptures indefinitely.
- § **Display:** Projects will be on display at City Hall until December 30. Winners can pick up their sculptures at City Hall after that date.
