ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS  
Westfield Street & Camp Street  
Public Works Department***

Work required pursuant to this contract includes furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and incidentals necessary to complete the roadway improvements to Westfield Street & Camp Street.

The work shall include but shall not be limited to the following classifications of work: earth excavation, road forming, installation of pavement structure, curbing, drainage structures and piping, turf establishment, sedimentation and erosion control, equipment operators and laborers, traffic control and other incidental work as required.

**A bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10.0%) of the total bid amount shall be required with all bids submitted. Performance and Labor and Materials Payment Bond(s) in the amount of 100% of the contract sum shall be required from the selected bidder following award. A Maintenance Bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the contract sum shall be required after completion of work and prior to final payment.**

**\*\*\*A pre-bid conference will be held on Tuesday, March 9, 2010 at 10:30 am in Room B20 of the Municipal Building, 245 Dekoven Drive, Middletown, CT. Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend this meeting in person or by representative.**

Bidders are encouraged to complete a site survey and or inspection prior to their submission of a Bid. Bid proposals must be executed in accordance with and are subject to the instructions contained within the Information for Bidders. Within thirty (30) days after opening the bids, the three (3) apparent lowest responsible bidders' bond documents will be retained and all others returned. The three (3) lowest responsible bidders' bond documents may be held for a period of up to ninety (90) calendar days or until a contract is signed and then all bond documents, other than those of the successful responsible bidder shall be returned.

Plans and Specifications may be obtained at the Purchasing Department, Room 112, Municipal Building, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8:30 a.m.

to 4:30 p.m. upon receipt of a **\$50.00 refundable deposit**. Deposits shall be made payable to the City of Middletown by cash, certified check or company /business check. **Personal checks will not be accepted**. The deposit will be refunded to each bidder submitting a bid who returns the plans and specifications in good condition within two (2) weeks from the opening of bids. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in Room 208, Municipal Building, Middletown, Connecticut. All bids shall be submitted on the designated forms and in the preprinted envelope provided and marked as designated in the Information for Bidders.

The City of Middletown reserves the right to waive any defect or any irregularity in any bid and reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any part thereof. Bids, and amendments to bids received after the time set for the bid opening will not be considered. All bids must be completely filled out when submitted. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days subsequent to the opening of bids without the City of Middletown's written consent. Withdrawal of any bid must be submitted in writing to the City of Middletown.
