Work required pursuant to this contract shall include furnishing all design, construction, labor, equipment, materials and incidentals required to perform the following: **To Design and Build an interior sanitary sewer main within the building, including the connection of all bathrooms to the main. All bidders must be CT State Licensed Plumber.**

A bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10.0%) of the total bid amount shall be required with all bids submitted. Performance and Labor and Materials Payment Bond(s) in the amount of 100% of the contract sum shall be required from the selected bidder following award. A Maintenance Bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the contract sum shall be required after completion of work and prior to final payment.

A pre-bid conference has been scheduled for **Friday, March 12th at 10:00 am** at the site, Remington Rand Building, 180 Johnson Street, Middletown, CT. All prospective bidders are invited to attend this meeting to allow for questions and clarifications of the contract documents and to insure their understanding prior to bidding the project. Representatives of all interested bidders are **strongly encouraged** to attend this meeting.

Plans and Specifications may be obtained at the Purchasing Department, Room 112, Municipal Building, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. upon receipt of a **\$25.00 refundable deposit**. Deposits shall be made payable to the City of Middletown by cash, certified check or company /business check. **Personal checks will not be accepted**. The deposit will be refunded to each bidder submitting a bid who returns the plans and specifications in good condition within two (2) weeks from the opening of bids. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in Room B20, Municipal Building, Middletown, Connecticut. All bids shall be submitted on the designated forms and in an envelope using the Bid Return Label as designated in the Information for Bidders.

The City of Middletown reserves the right to waive any defect or any irregularity in any bid and reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any part thereof. Bids, amendments to bids or withdrawals of bids received after the time set for the bid opening will not be considered. All bids must be completely filled out when submitted. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days subsequent to the opening of bids without the City of Middletown's written consent. Withdrawal of any bid must be submitted in writing to the City of Middletown. All bids and proposals are subject to, and must comply with the equal opportunity and non-discriminatory provisions set forth in the Affirmative Action

Plan of the City of Middletown.
